- 1. Write a **sentence** that uses the word correctly.
- 2. Two synonyms and two antonyms for the vocabulary word.
- 3. A picture or clip art with an explanation of why the image relates to the vocabulary word.
- 4. A "Mr. Stick" drawing with a dialogue bubble or caption; the bubble or caption must correctly use the word.
- 5. <u>Three different-but-related words</u>. This does not mean adding a prefix or suffix to the word, like *un* or -*ing* or -*s*. A different-but-related word means the vocabulary word shares a common root with three other words. If my vocabulary word is *fortitude*, for example, then the related words might be *fortress*, *fortify*, and *forte*.
- 6. A <u>personified description of a character</u> whose last name is the vocabulary word. The description must connect the word's meaning to the "person's" personality or job.
