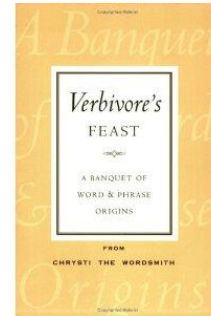


Vocabulary October 10
